PROFIT WARNING – REDUCTION IN PROFIT

This announcement is made by Daohe Global Group Limited (the “**Company**”, together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) pursuant to Rule 13.09(2)(a) of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the “**Listing Rules**”) and the Inside Information Provisions (as defined in the Listing Rules) under Part XIVA of the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Chapter 571 of the Laws of Hong Kong).

The board (the “**Board**”) of directors (the “**Directors**”) of the Company wishes to inform the shareholders of the Company (the “**Shareholders**”) and potential investors that based on the preliminary review of the latest unaudited consolidated management accounts of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2025, and the information currently available to the Board, the Group is expected to record a consolidated profit for the year ended 31 December 2025 of not more than US\$0.1 million, which represented a significant reduction in profit as compared to the consolidated profit for the year ended 31 December 2024 (approximately US\$2.7 million).

The Board considers that the expected reduction in consolidated profit for the year ended 31 December 2025 is primarily due to the following reasons:

1. a decrease in revenue from the trading and supply chain management services segment by approximately 21% year-on-year, impacted by a challenging and uncertain business environment exacerbated by the ongoing international trade tensions, which dampened customer sentiment and led to more conservative ordering practices; and
2. a decrease in revenue from the culture and entertainment segment by approximately 23% year-on-year, driven by a slowdown in the pop toys business as a result of product oversaturation and weakened consumer spending.

The information contained in this announcement is solely based on the preliminary assessment made by the Group with reference to the unaudited consolidated management accounts and the information currently available and has not been reviewed nor audited by the auditors of the Company. The Group's actual results for the year ended 31 December 2025 remains to be subject to finalisation and adjustment based on further updated information and may differ from the information contained in this announcement. The Company will closely monitor the situation and provide further update when necessary.

Detailed financial information of the Group will be disclosed in the audited annual results announcement of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2025, which is expected to be published by late March 2026. Shareholders and potential investors are advised to read the audited annual results announcement of the Group when it is published.

Shareholders and potential investors are advised to exercise caution when dealing in the shares of the Company.
